- Analyze cost breakdowns from supplier quotes and understand all cost influential factors

- Collect and maintain up to date costs of material, labor, and desired profit margin for each product for use in creating estimates
- Understanding of engineering drawings and technical specifications
- Request quotes for materials, purchased items, and outside services, or line up assisting teammates to do so
